**Item 4. PLANNING**

a) **To discuss and RESOLVE the Parish Council's response to the following planning applications:**

**PA15/05864** Mr Robbie Ryder, Trebor Maintenance Ltd, Land North West of Horsepool Lane, SheviocK, Cornwall. Proposed wooden building for use as a bee keeping store. Grid Ref: 236232/55174. Councillor McLaren had visited the site and said that the development was not visible from the road and that there are no near neighbours. It was **RESOLVED** to support the application, **proposed by Councillor Medway and seconded by Councillor Isaac and all were in favour.**

**PA15/06789** Mr Peter Harrison, St Mary's Parochial Church Council. St Mary's Church A374, between access to Trewin House and access to Trehill House, SheviocK, Cornwall. Listed Building Consent to rebuild damaged wall re-using existing stone and any necessary replacement stone to match with natural hydraulic lime mortar. Grid Ref: 237018/55095. Councillor McLaren had visited the site and reported that the damage to the wall had been caused by a tree root pushing out the stones. It was **RESOLVED** to support the application. **Councillor Medway proposed, Councillor Mrs Jenny Bushrod seconded and all were in favour.**
