The diagram Below shows, in general, which issues are suited to a particular type of plan. As you can see Community Led Plans are useful when looking at your community as a whole and when you want to look at a wide range of issues. Unlike Community Led Plans, Neighbourhood Plans are part of formal planning policy and therefore are better at addressing particular land use or development issues in your community. It is entirely possible for a community to undertake (or combine) both processes and therefore have a much more rounded vision for the future of the community. When looking at the diagram the sold arrows indicate a strong link, and the dotted ones indicate a weaker link. These are however only a general summary and each plan is likely to be different
