**3.PUBLIC PARTICIAPTION AND RESPONSE TO PUBLIC PARTICIAPTION:** It was agreed that there would be no further need for public participation following an extended Parish meeting to obtain all views of the public immediately prior to the meeting.

5.PLANNING:To resolve response to notice of new planning application PA12/07469 the permanent retention of the existing cafe, ventilation/system, fencing and ramped access together with temporary permission for a period of 6 months for the retention of the existing generator and fuel tank.
