### Treasurer's report

The current balance of funds is £30,521.05 – £16,867 ring-fenced for extension so <u>actual money available £8,654.06 plus £5,000 contingency fund</u>.

Quite a quiet month, major unusual cost £99.99 for new vacuum cleaner. Income is good – election and 200 club. Also 2 payments in from Fish and chip team and they will pay quarterly. Estimated quarter for solar panels is approx. £930. Chris estimates by the end of the year we will have paid off the solar panel initial cost.

### **General Maintenance report**

Barbara noted that one night recently the defribulator was flashing, not noticed it since. Chris K will talk to the Parish Council.

Andy spotted a small hole in the eaves in the sports hall.

Judy – The door into the sorts hall are getting more and more damaged and she asked about a "kick plate" and a metal strip down the edges due to damage from the chair trolleys.

Mike S says that the repair is in hand due to some damage that happened recently.

Barbara says that some new curtain hooks are needed in the sports hall and lounge.

There is a grey strip of tape on the floor of the sports hall and needs to be removed – Andy to look into this.
