## Item 6 on minutes 13/11/2017.

Under the item which reads "Mr P. McLaren suggested that it may have been his initial comment at the above meeting that had caused the debate and he apologised if that were the case."

Mr McLaren requested that it should be changed/explained as follows:

"I would like to disagree with the wording of the sentence which wrongly quotes my comment on "a residents' inquiry as to "a councillor commenting on the capability of volunteers to record the incidents in the traffic light trial", it was a fact that, it was debated at the Project Board meeting and refuted by the chairman, as irrelevant in the context of the discussion and my apology was, that I had made the comment by the councillor public, and caused the resident concerns that the comment by the councillor was directed at all volunteers and not just COVAG.

I also apologised for, "actually naming" the Councillor during the council meeting which was not the normal protocol.

It was agreed by the Clerk and the Parish Council that the clerk had initially interpreted it incorrectly.
