The Sheviock Parish Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given that Sheviock Parish Council proposes to make the above Order under the road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, in accordance with schedule 9 of the Act. This order will replace the existing Sheviock Parish Council (Off Street) Parking Order 2016.

This notice is intended to provide an indication of the Orders provisions, as outlined below. The Sheviock Parish Council (Off Street) Parking Order 2025 will introduce conditions of use (for the Sheviock Parish Council run Seafront Public Car Park, Portwrinkle,) including:

Motorhomes/campers prohibited between the hours of 23:00 to 08:00: due to waste from some of the previous motorhomes/campers being inappropriately disposed of in the Public Toilets and causing spillages; Use of Car Park as camping area instead of using an appropriate campsite with correct facilities. Complaints from residents.

An increase to the summer tariffs: to cover inflation and the increased running costs of the Portwrinkle Public Toilets, plus to accrue funds for their future upgrade. Please note that the tariffs have not been amended since 2014. Winter tariffs will remain the same, so that the increase in parking charges is mostly covered by visitors/tourists to the area who are more likely to use the Public Toilets.

Have your say - Public Consultation

Sheviock Parish Council is now asking for your views before making any decisions. The full proposed Parking Order and schedule (which includes the proposed tariffs) is available via the Parish Council's Website or direct from The Clerk by appointments -see details above.
